



2013 Cline Viognier (California - Sonoma, United States)
Wine - White \$17.99 (750mL)

This shows big pineapple, peach and apricot flavors mixed with citrus and floral notes. This full-bodied flavorful wine is an excellent match for Mediterranean stews, Thai curry and spicy Mexican dishes.



2013 Mason Cellars Pomelo Sauvignon Blanc (California - Napa Valley, United States)
Wine - White \$20.99 (750mL)

Primarily sourced from Lake County, Pomelo's characteristic grapefruit profile is consistently found in the blocks situated on the Kelseyville bench. With an elevation of nearly 1300', the growing season is long, with ample hours of sunshine and great diurnal temperature fluctuations-

all responsible for the explosive flavors found in Pomelo.

100% Sauvignon Blanc. Fermented in all stainless steel tanks; extremely long and cold ferment allows for the fragrant and big fruit flavors to be appreciated. The crisp acidity is retained and then rounded out and complimented by a broadened mouth and ever-slight sweetness.

A mouth-watering, vivid style; this wine explodes with delicious flavors of passion fruit, guava, quince, lime peel; with an intensely grapefruit nose.



2012 Château St. Jean Chardonnay (California - Sonoma, United States)
Wine - White \$21.49 (750mL)

Rich, offering ripe Golden Delicious and Granny Smith apple notes, with pretty spice and light oak shadings. Ends with a subtle mix of nuanced flavors. Drink now. 8,000 cases made.



2012 Ravenswood Lodi Old Vine Zinfandel (California - Lodi, United States)
Wine - Red \$28.99 (750mL)

Big, bold, and unapologetic. This 2012 rendition leads the charge with tantalizing aromas of black cherry, raspberries, and blueberries along with hints of oak. It then gets really serious with a cascade of fruit flavors, flexible tannins, and a long, fruit-forward finish you're not going to forget very easily.



2010 Neal Family Cabernet Sauvignon (California - Napa Valley, United States)
Wine - Red \$59.99 (750mL)

While young in the scale of things, **Neal Family** has quickly gain notoriety for their superior Cabernet Sauvignons. Mark Neal has spent lots of money and sweat to bring this Napa Valley winery to the forefront of the new avant garde.

The great 2010 vintage was produced from mostly Rutherford vineyards with only 24% coming from Howell Mountain. Aromas of ripe cherry, cassis, olive and black licorice. Dark ruby in color with a nose that matches the palate flavors. Intense cherry fruit, spice (white pepper), toast and vanilla on the finish. Bold tannin and balanced acidity suggests a long life ahead. Previous vintages have all been a deVine bestseller.



NV Pacific Rim Framboise (California, United States)
Wine - Dessert \$25.99 (375mL)

The wine authority can generally effect an air of dignity and earnest reverence in the presence of the subject of his or her ardor. But gathered in herds, wine geeks inevitably fall prey to the temptation to describe, and describe in such a fashion as to demonstrate the length of one's thesaurus.

Fortunately, we have Framboise, a potion so singular in its sensory frequency that we may leave our descriptor lists at home. This is all and simply about the raspberry and the ingenious ways we might integrate Framboise into our lives. Perhaps the thesaurus is not without utility, for with the continued increase in the percentage of the Morrison variety, we must find new ways of expressing what lies beyond lashings of raspberry, explosions of raspberry flavor, eruptions of raspberry zest, the quiddity of the essence raspberry, an extravasation of raspberry lava, etc. Or, simply pour a generous slosh over some flourless chocolate cake and know what it is to sit under a banyan tree and contemplate new found enlightenment.
